



Plainview Country Club's 40 Degree Course Playability Standard:

1. The outdoor, ambient temperature must be equal to or above 40 degrees, **and:**
2. The Playing Field of the golf course must be free of ice, snow, and frost. The Playing Field consists of Tees, Primary Rough, Fairways and Approaches, Collars, and Greens; **and:**
3. The Green's surface must be thawed to a depth of at least 2 ½" or greater.

All three of these criteria must be met simultaneously for the golf course at Plainview Country Club to be deemed playable, and any member or guest be allowed to access our golf facility.

Please know that these standards are in place to protect the integrity of our facility, with special and unconditional attention given to our greens above all else.
